- 2. Attach an **official** transcript from your school (as of the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of your senior year). This should include your attendance record, GPA, and current class ranking to that point.
- 3. If you have been involved with community service or faith-based activities in the past, include two signed testimonial letters from <a href="two">two</a> supervising adults as to the nature and extent of your involvement. Letters should not be from family members.
- 4. A document that addresses topics found on Part 2 of Page 2.
